- you want a low risk of breakage or theft of goods during transportation.

Sea freight from China to Canada^{n 100 kg}

Ocean shipping from China to Canada is the most cost-effective delivery method. Ocean freight is ideal for larger shipments, as transporting goods takes longer (from 30 days). However, it is often the best option for bulky or heavy items that would be prohibitively expensive to ship by air.

- higher throughput capacity compared to air freight ships are capable of carrying large volumes of cargo, while the size and weight of the plane limits air transportation;
- lower transportation costs in general.

How to ship from China to Canada

FCL and LCL shipping from China to Canada

FCL shipping from China to Canada - to deliver your goods in a full container (20, 40, or 45-foot container) fully loaded with your goods.

A Full Container Load shipping method is required when:

- there is a large batch of cargo (from 20 m³);
- it is necessary to send a large batch of goods at once without dividing them into several transportations;
- it is needed to assemble, load, and ship the cargo quickly.

LCL - is the placement of cargo from several shippers in one container.

Cargo consolidation (Less Container Load) is chosen when:

- cargo volume is less than 20 m³;
- it is necessary to reduce the financial burden per unit of time and distribute the costs over several transportation;
- there is an opportunity to wait more time.

Sea Shipping Routes from China to Canada

Sea transportation is a popular and profitable choice for shipping goods to Canada from China. Several sea shipping routes are available to facilitate cargo movement between these two countries.

1. **Trans-Pacific Route**: this is the primary seaway connecting China and Canada. Ships depart from main Chinese ports, such as Shanghai, Ningbo, or Shenzhen, and travel across the Pacific Ocean to reach ports in Canada.

Import customs clearance in Canada

Here are the customs processes and the steps involved in clearing goods for import cargo in Canada:

1. Preparation for import:

- obtaining a Business Number from the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA).
- identifying the type and country of origin items you want to import.
- ensuring the goods you wish to import are permitted into Canada.

2.Goods classifying. The products you import must be classified under the Harmonized System (HS) tariff, which determines the applicable import taxes.

3.Determination of duties and taxes. These are based on the HS tariff, the quantity and value of the goods, and the country of origin.

4.Shipment and reporting of goods. When your cargo arrives in Canada, it will be imported through a Canadian Border Services Agency (CBSA) office. You will need to provide the CBSA with the following information:

- your Business Number;
- the HS tariff classification of items;
- the quantity and value of the cargo;
- the country of origin of your good;

5.Passing customs control. Once the CBSA has reviewed your paperwork, they will release your goods.
